



DO IT YOURSELF KITS

All kits come with both left and right sides and include an applicator. Graphics can be removed at any time with a little effort, but they can not be re-used, so get it right the first time or you will have to buy another kit.

The Kits are quite easy to install if you follow the instructions.

The Kits come displayed in a clear plastic sleeve with one side displayed. The best option is to tape the graphic (still in its packet) onto the side of the vehicle where you would like it placed and adjust it until you are happy. Mark where the corners are on the vehicle.

You can install the graphic 'WET' or 'DRY'.

Wet installation requires more time but is safer.

Wetting Solution: Add a few drops of dishwashing liquid to a spray bottle of water.

- 1: Clean area with soap and water and dry.
- 2: Find position for Graphic by holding it onto car and marking.
- 3: Spray area with water solution. Peel backing paper off graphic & spray back of graphic. Position onto car.
- 4: Make sure graphic is sitting flat on surface. Use the applicator as a squeegee and work from the centre of the graphic upwards then from above centre downwards pushing all the water and air out from under the graphic.
- 5: You may have to wait 15 – 30 minutes before removing application tape, depending on temperature. Peel application tape off slowly making sure the graphic stays in position, pulling tape back onto itself as not to lift graphic.
- 6: Once application tape has been removed check for bubbles & creases. You can use a pin to pop any air bubbles, but will find most small bubbles will disappear in a couple of days as the adhesive sets.

NOTE: You can also apply in the same way without the water solution remembering that when it is on the surface, you will not be able to shift the graphic around. It's like sticking two pieces of tape together. It's very hard to get them apart without stretching.

You can have your kits professionally fitted. Most sign shops will fit your graphic for a fee.
